Since the death of Vincent Mulliez in May 2010, his wife Isabelle took over the management of the Civil Society of Gironville to pursue with determination the work begun by her husband. This rigorous and enterprising man had succeeded in a few years to impose its three properties, Belle-Vue, Gironville and Bolaire among the best recognition in the Médoc.

- Average area: 15.58 hectares
- Average age of vines: 32 years (the most recent were planted in 2007)
- Global vines: Cabernet Sauvignon (50%), Merlot (30%) and Petit Verdot (20%)
- Rearing time: 12 to 16 months in oak barrels
